Attached is tabulation reflecting your institution's share of the fiscal year (FY) 2010 formula allocation for the Expanded Food and Nutrition Education Program (EFNEP) appropriated under section 3(d) of the Smith-Lever Act. These funds are distributed according to the statutory formula under section 1425(c) of the National Agricultural Research, Extension, and Teaching Policy Act of 1977 (NARETPA) (7 U.S.C. 3175(c)).

Section 7116 of the Food, Conservation, and Energy Act of 2008 (FCEA) amended section 1425 of the NARETPA to revise the EFNEP formula. A of the FY 2009 EFNEP Formula Grant Opportunity (FGO).

NIFA (CSREES) transitioned to Grants.gov in FY 2008 for the submission of all administrative requirements via the SF-424 Mandatory Application Forms. NIFA is soliciting for these Applications via Formula Grant Opportunities (FGOs) which will provide instructions for the completion of these application forms. NIFA will notify eligible institutions when the instructions and forms are available on the Grants.gov site. NIFA will release the FY 2010 EFNEP FGO – Final by January 31, 2010.

These funds will be made available on a quarterly basis through the Automated Standard Application for Payments System (ASAP).
