SUBJECT: Allocation of Fiscal Year 2009 Pesticide Safety Education Program Funds

A signed Interagency Agreement between the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and the Cooperative State Research, Education, and Extension Service, United States Department of Agriculture, has made available \$1,600,000 for Fiscal Year (FY) 2009 for the Pesticide Safety Education Program (PSEP). This amount is distributed based on an amended formula developed by EPA in 2008. The FY 2009 allocation was distributed between two (2) financial data codes: 48024, regular PSEP funds in the amount of \$1,100,000 and 48679, PRIA funds in the amount of \$500,000. In accordance with EPA guidelines, PRIA dollars must be drawn down first from the Department of Health and Human Services, Payment Management System. The attached table shows each State's share of allocated funds. States are permitted to use up to 10 percent of their PSEP budget to fund new equipment. Further, the State contribution must equal the Federal formula grant funds.

As stated in my April 9, 2008 memorandum, "Update on CSREES Formula Policies and Procedures," CSREES will be transitioning to Grants.gov in FY 2008 for the submission of all administrative requirements via the SF-424 Mandatory Application Forms. CSREES will be soliciting for these applications via Formula Grant Opportunities (FGOs) which will provide instructions for the completion and submission of these forms. CSREES will notify eligible institutions when the instructions and forms are available on the Grants.gov site. Therefore, there are no reporting requirements at this time. Please note that this process will not change any current reporting processes such as the Plan of Work. The FGOs for this program will only require the Form SF-424 Mandatory, Budget Information for Non-Construction Programs, CSREES Supplemental Information Form, and the SF-424 Key Contacts Form. These funds are available for expenditure through September 30, 2010.

A Planning and Reporting page has been established on our website to assist you in locating the requirements, due dates, and submission information on PSEP funds and all other formula grant funds. The research and extension formulas are organized in groups for the three land-grant types: 1862 Land-Grant Institutions, 1862 Land-Grant Institutions in the U.S. Territories, and the 1890 Land-Grant institutions. Since funding continues to be contingent upon meeting planning and reporting requirements, you may want to have your administrative staff bookmark the following web link for easy access.
